

NetApp's Compliance with WEEE and RoHS Directives

NetApp is committed to compliance with all applicable laws and regulations, including the European Union's Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) and Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) directives.



NetApp has processes in place to comply with the WEEE directive. All NetApp products are properly labeled. NetApp is the registered producer in the EU and works with a local recycler in the EU for all product lines. The NetApp approved recycler is responsible for collecting the products and for recycling in a safe and responsible manner.

NetApp has plans and processes in place to comply with the RoHS directive by **July 1, 2006**. RoHS substances will be eliminated or reduced to levels below legal limits for all NetApp products sold in the EU, except where we must take an exemption as allowed by the EU RoHS directive.
